

- ladies who have wisdom/gifts/talents/abilities to share with peers and those younger;
- ladies who might be considering a career in counseling, life or athletic coaching, teaching, social work or other humanitarian occupations.

#### As representatives of After School Buddies volunteers must be ladies who

- are willing to demonstrate unconditional love and acceptance of others;
- WILL COMMIT to <u>REGULAR</u> and timely attendance each week or work as a team with others who
  will provide regular support/leadership;
- want to experience personal leadership development;
- will be willing to fulfill commitments for leadership roles;
- are willing to observe stated communication standards: using email/text and reading and responding to such in a timely fashion;
- will **limit the use of cell phones and tablets** for non-ASB communication during program time;
- are willing to observe <u>modest dress code standards</u> and refrain from use of inappropriate language and photos – **especially on social media** including Facebook, Instagram and Snapchat;
- will engage in truthful, accurate and fair communication that facilitates respect and mutual understanding;
- are **not** already **TOO busy** with other activities;
- have **family support** for this volunteer effort.
